What Can Cover Crops Do For You?

- ✓ **Erosion Control – Soil has to stay in the field**
- ✓ **Better Infiltration – Cant grow a crop with water that runs off of the field**
- ✓ **Weed Control – Keeping the ground covered inhibits weeds ability to grow and less of a need for herbicides**
- ✓ **Less Compaction – Live root keeps soil aggregated**
- ✓ **White Mold Control – Reduce spore splash in soybean flowers**
- ✓ **Jump Start Biology – Initiate active ffungi in spring**
- ✓ **Transpire Water in Spring- Drier soil is warmer soil**
- ✓ **Cycle Nutrients – Biomass brings nutrients(NPK) to soil surface making it more available**
- ✓ **Plant in Wet Conditions – Living roots wont smear, less mud on guage wheels**
- ✓ **Add Carbon – Vegetative stage plants pump carbon into soil**
- ✓ **Grazing for Livestock**
